Applicants must have their own vehicle which meets the specification detailed below:

The post holder will convey non-emergency walking patients to and from their designated appointments (usually within the London area) in their own vehicle, in a safe, and efficient manner. The post holder is required to use their own vehicle and is paid at an agreed rate for price per journey.

We are looking for caring and enthusiastic individuals to provide appropriate and necessary assistance for patients to access vehicles. This may include physically supporting patients or manoeuvring of porter chairs around hazards or in constricted environments. The individual must also ensure that patients have all relevant and necessary paperwork, medication etc. required for attendance at appointment.

The role involves reviewing planned journeys to optimise routes, maximising efficiency whilst complying with any expected standards for patient care and timeliness. The post holder must be able and willing to do both local and long-distance journeys. Manual handling and first Aid training will be provided by the company.

All successful applicants will be subject to an enhanced DBS disclosure, Driving Licence check and pre-work referencing. You will also be required to attend an induction day, whereby we will carry out a basic driving assessment and a company induction.

- Must have a five-door saloon car which is less than 5 years old
- Ensure own vehicle is road worthy and maintained to a high standard.
- Insurance, MOT and Servicing records must be kept up to date and documentation available for review when requested.
- Business Class 1 insurance or above is required
